Founded in 1889, Pocatello was known as the "Gateway to the Northwest." While the gold rush and opportunity for railroad work drew people here in the mid-19th century, Idaho State University, quality of life, and exceptional housing costs are today's newcomer allurement. **U.S. Smile Capital**. In 1948, the Mayor of the City of Pocatello, George Phillips, passed an ordinance making it illegal not to smile in Pocatello. Traditionally, our status as the U.S. Smile Capital is celebrated with a poster contest for elementary school children, a smile contest, "arrests" of those who do not smile, and a community celebration.

GREAT AREA ATTRACTIONS

Yellowstone, the Tetons, and the Rocky Mountains

Amazing outdoor recreation and scenic beauty grace the area. Pocatello is uniquely positioned at a central point between some of the nation's greatest playgrounds. The city is within a few hours' drive of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, and equally close to world-renowned ski areas like Jackson Hole, Wyoming, Sun Valley, Idaho and Utah's Salt Lake City.



World-class mountain bike trails, challenging rock-climbing, golf courses and an active Greenway are some of the offerings located right in Pocatello. The valley is surrounded by mountains laced with incredible trails that support outdoor enthusiasts at every level of conditioning and experience. The best part is, they are just minutes away. You'll find everything from heart-pounding mountain bike rides to relaxing nature walks.

Cost of Living

Pocatello's incredibly affordable cost of living and housing is one of the most enticing reasons to move there. The cost of living in Pocatello is 6% lower than the average in Idaho, and 13% lower than the national average. The cost of housing is 27% lower than the national average. The median home price and property value in Pocatello is \$133,700, with an average property tax of \$1,020. The median rent for a one-bedroom apartment is \$492, and 4-bedroom is \$1,149. The average salary in Pocatello, ID is \$40,269, so depending how yours compares, it should determine which housing option is best for you.

Higher Education

Pocatello Idaho State University, a Carnegie-classified doctoral research and teaching institution founded in 1901, attracts students from around the world to its Idaho campuses. At the main campus in Pocatello and at locations in Meridian, Idaho Falls and Twin Falls, ISU offers more than 250 programs to almost 15,000 students. ISU is the state's leading institution in health professions and medical education, awarding 75 percent of the state's health profession degrees.



An Outdoorsman's Dream

A hunting and fishing paradise, residents of Southeastern Idaho may choose to fish year-round from some of the Northwest's finest mountain lakes, rivers and crystal-clear trout streams. Popular fishing spots include the South Fork of the Snake River, Henry's Fork, and the Madison and Teton Rivers.

Visitors and residents alike enjoy relaxing in the steaming, outdoor mineral hot pools at Lava Hot Springs. Just a 35-minute drive south of Pocatello, this small Idaho community is home to a year-round resort/spa complex, which includes a free-form Olympic-size pool with a three-stage 10-meter diving tower, four outdoor mineral water pools, and three private, whirlpool-equipped indoor pools. The pools are filled from natural hot water springs that are sulfur-free, odor-free, and chlorine free.

Venues

Arts and events in Pocatello keep residents inspired year-round. During warm-weather months, the 11,000 seat Portneuf Health Trust Amphitheatre, the largest of its kind in the state, entertains audiences with top acts from around the world, while offering beautiful mountain and lake views. For year-round entertainment, Idaho State University's \$34 million L.E. and Thelma E. Stephens Performing Arts Center is one of the regions outstanding spaces for up-and-coming talent, concerts, plays and lectures. For more intimate musical entertainment, the Westside Players and Palace Playhouse schedules offer a variety of excellent plays and musicals.

Museums

Learn to squeegee at the world's one-and-only Museum of Clean, explore the world's largest collection of vacuum devices and take a selfie with the world's first motor-driven horse-drawn vacuum. Washers, chimney sweeps, a giant ark, kid's clean world and more fill this 75,000-sq. ft. LEED's certified facility. Ross Park, the city's largest park, is home to the Pocatello Aquatic Center and the Pocatello Zoo. See cougars, bison, elk and the other native species of Yellowstone and the Rocky Mountains up-close at the Pocatello Zoo. Visit the Grizzly for dinner as he fishes his stream in the unique Grizzly Habitat. Ross Park's upper level houses the Bannock County Historical Museum, Pioneer Village, a disc-golf course, a Veteran's Memorial and the Fort Hall Replica. Step into the outdoors at the Edson Fichter Nature Area along the Portneuf Greenway. Pocatello has 32 parks, many with picnic and playground areas and covered pavilions. Each first Friday of the month join an Art Walk and meander through Old Town's art galleries, antique stores and shops to the tune of local musicians.





Nightlife

Embrace Old town, the downtown district featuring specialty shops, antique stores, bakeries, galleries and restaurants. Raise a glass at Portneuf Valley Brewing featuring several microbrew selections with a full menu and live music five nights a week. Old Town hosts an annual Portneuf Valley Farmers Market from Spring to Fall. Stop at the Green T Western Bar for lunch and a fabulously fun wild west reenactment, tour historic Old Town, the Museum of Clean–or for the adventure traveler– hike the City Creek Trail System.
